

2 インフルエンザ等学校感染症 罹患等に対する追検査について

都立高校には、インフルエンザ等学校感染症の罹患や病気による入院等のために、第一次募集を受検できなかった生徒の受検機会を確保することを目的とした「追検査」という入試制度があります。追検査は、分割後期募集・全日制第二次募集と同日程で実施します。

なお、分割募集を実施する学校は、同日程で分割後期募集を実施するため、追検査を実施しません。また、推薦入試や海外帰国生徒等対象の入試など、その他の選抜でも追検査は実施しません。

また、インフルエンザ等学校感染症の罹患や病気による入院等のために、追検査等を受検できなかった生徒は「追々検査」を受検することができます。追々検査についての詳細は、後日東京都教育委員会のホームページ等でお知らせします。

※ 新型コロナウイルス感染症についても、追検査及び追々検査の対象となります。

学校感染症等で検査を欠席した場合の申請について

- 学校感染症の罹患等により検査を欠席した場合で、追検査を希望するときは、中学校の先生に連絡し、相談してください（在籍する中学校から受検する高校へ欠席の連絡をすることになっています。）。
- 中学校に連絡した後、速やかに追検査の措置申請書を中学校の先生にも見てもらい、出願した高校へ提出します。
なお、既に中学校を卒業している人は、欠席の連絡も追検査の措置申請書の提出も、本人又は保護者が直接、出願した高校に行きます。
- 出願日に、入学願書等のほか、医療機関の証明書（罹患証明書等）又は中学校長が出席停止の措置を行ったことを証明する書類を高校へ提出します。
- 追々検査についても同様の申請を行ってください。

2 Make-up Examination for Applicants who Developed Designated School Infectious Diseases such as Influenza

Tokyo metropolitan high schools have an entrance examination system called “Make-up Examination” with the aim of securing the opportunity for students who were unable to take an examination of the first round of admissions due to designated school infectious diseases such as influenza or diseases which require hospitalization. The make-up examination is implemented in the same time schedule as the examination of the second round of admissions/second phase of application period for full-time high schools.

Please note that schools which provide two-phase application period will not offer the make-up examination because the second phase of application is proceeded in the same time schedule. In addition, for other admissions such as recommendation-based admissions, admissions for foreign students returning or repatriating to Japan, admission for foreign students residing in Tokyo, and admission for International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (at Kokusai High School), the make-up examination will not be offered either.

Furthermore, students who were unable to take the make-up examination due to designated school infectious diseases such as influenza or diseases which require hospitalization can take an "additional make-up examination." Details of this examination will be announced on the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education website, etc. at a later date.

※ Applicants with the coronavirus disease will also be covered by the make-up examination and the additional make-up examination

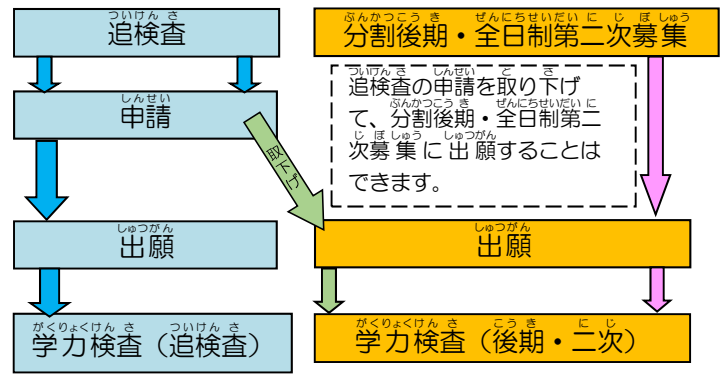
Application procedures for the case where an applicant was absent from the examination due to designated school infectious diseases, etc.

- In case you were absent from the examination due to designated school infectious diseases, etc. and wish to take the make-up examination, please inform and consult with your junior high school teacher. (The junior high school you belong to is supposed to inform the high school you applied of your absence.)
- After informing your junior high school of your absence, ask your junior high school teacher to check your application document for the make-up examination promptly and submit it to the high school you applied.
If you have already graduated from junior high school, you or your guardians should directly inform the high school you applied of your absence and submit the application document for the make-up examination.
- Submit a medical certificate (such as a medical certificate of illness, etc.) or a document certifying that the principal of your junior high school took a measure of suspension of attendance in addition to your application for admission to the high school on the application date.
- Please take the same procedures for the additional make-up examination.

追検査の日程

- 追検査は、分割後期募集・全日制第二次募集と同じ日程で実施します。
- 追検査に申請した人は、申請を取り下げて分割後期募集や全日制第二次募集に出願することはできませんが、追検査か分割後期募集・全日制第二次募集かのどちらか一方にしか出願できません。また、分割後期募集・全日制第二次募集に出願後、申請を取り下げて追検査に再提出することもできません。
- 追検査の日程については11月上旬に発行予定の「令和4年度東京都立高等学校募集案内」で確認してください。

追検査での検査内容

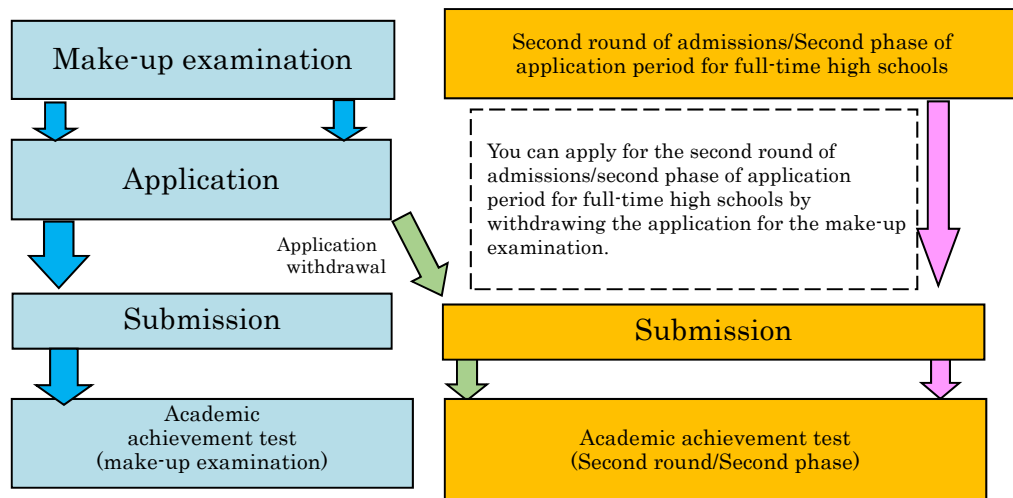
- 追検査では、国語・数学・英語の3教科の学力検査と、各学校で定める検査を組み合わせ実施します。各学校で定める検査内容については、11月上旬に発行予定の「令和4年度東京都立高等学校募集案内」で確認してください。
- 追検査で使用する学力検査問題は、分割後期募集・全日制第二次募集と同一のものになります。
- 追検査では、国語・数学・英語の3教科の学力検査と、各学校で定める検査を組み合わせ実施しますが、詳細は後日東京都教育委員会のホームページ等でお知らせします。

検査当日に向けて体調を整えることが大切です。うがい・手洗いをこまめに行い、体調管理をしっかりと行うとともに、インフルエンザ等学校感染症に罹患してしまうなど万一のことを考え、追検査等の制度について事前に確認をしておきましょう。

Time schedule for the make-up examination

- Make-up examination is conducted in the same time schedule as the examination of the second round of admission/second phase of application period.
- An applicant for the make-up examination can apply for the second round of admission/second phase of application period for full-time high schools by withdrawing the application for make-up examination. However, he/she can take only either of them. Moreover, an applicant for the second round of admission/second phase of application period for full-time high schools cannot withdraw the application to resubmit the application for the make-up examination.
- Please check the time schedule for the additional make-up examination in the “Tokyo Metropolitan High Schools Guide to Admissions 2022 Academic Year” to be issued in early November.

Contents of the make-up examination

- An academic achievement test of Japanese, math and English combined with an examination set by each school will be conducted. As for the contents of the examination set by each school, please see “Tokyo Metropolitan High Schools Guide to Admissions 2022 Academic Year” to be issued in early November.
- Questions of the academic achievement test used for the make-up examination are the same as the ones used for the second round of admissions/second phase of application period for full-time high schools.
- The additional make-up examination will be conducted by combining the academic achievement test of the three subjects, Japanese, math, and English with an examination set by each school. Details will be announced on the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education website, etc. at a later date.

It is very important to keep fit to prepare for the date of examination. You are strongly encouraged to gargle and wash hands frequently to keep a good health condition. Yet at the same time, you should check the procedure of the make-up examination in advance to be aware that you may develop designated school infectious diseases such as influenza.
