- 事例2 電学3年生である志願者は、一家でB県に在催している。都内に在催する母先の植母が曼介護3 の認定を受けたので、母は祖母を介護するため、都内の祖母宅で同居することとした。父は仕事の関係でB県に残らなければならないことから、父及び母は、志願者が母と同居する先が身上監護を受けられると判断し、電学校卒業を機に、志願者は母と都内の祖母宅で同居することとした。

• Cases where a student is eligible for application

- Case 1: A third-year junior high school applicant lives in Prefecture A with his/her whole family including a grandfather who is certified as level 5 of long-term care need. The applicant's father is assigned to work in Tokyo and moves to Tokyo by himself because it is difficult for him to commute to the workplace from Prefecture A. Since the applicant's mother continuously needs to devote herself to grandfather's care, his/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her father, and the applicant has decided to live with him in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school.
- Case 2: A third-year junior high school applicant lives in Prefecture B with his/her whole family. Since his/her maternal grandmother living in Tokyo is certified as level 3 of long-term care need, his/her mother will live with his/her grandmother in Tokyo to take care of her, while his/her father has to stay in Prefecture B due to his work. His/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her mother, and the applicant has decided to live with her in his/her grandmother's house in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school.
- Case 3: A third-year junior high school applicant lives with his/her whole family including his/her grandmother in Prefecture C. While his/her mother is hospitalized to receive medical treatment in Prefecture C, his/her father is assigned to work in Tokyo. Since it is difficult for him to commute to the workplace from Prefecture C, he moved to Tokyo by himself. Because his/her mother will be continuously hospitalized even after April 1, 2024 in Prefecture C, his/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her father, and the applicant has decided to live with him in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school. His/her mother will move to Tokyo as soon as she recovers from her illness.

Q18 外国籍の場合、都立高校に応募できますか。

A18 都立高校への応募資格を満たせば、どの都立高校にも応募することができます。

なお、日本に気菌後3年以内の外国籍の志願者は、志願する高校が都立高校共通問題で学力検査を実施する場合、申請により、ひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った学力検査問題(共通問題)ではひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った学力検査問題(共通問題)に加えて許書の持込み及び学力検査時間の延長での受検が可能です(ただし、国語の学力検査では許書の持込み及び学力検査時間の延長はありません。)。日本に気菌後3年を超えていても、気菌後6年以内であれば、ひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った検査問題での受検は可能です(A13参照)。

また、竹台高校、由柄高校、南葛飾高校、府中西高校、飛鳥高校、六郷工科高校、杉並総合高校 茂び国際高校では、一定の応募資格の下、在京外国人生徒対象の予試(4月入学・9月入学(六郷工科高校及び杉並総合高校を除く。))を実施しています。ただし、国際高校以外の7校のいずれかの高校に合格した場合は、入学手続を行っていなくても、後日検査を実施する国際高校に応募することはできません。

Q18. I am not a citizen of Japan. Am I eligible to apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school?

A18. As long as you meet the eligibility requirements for the application for a Tokyo metropolitan high school, you are eligible to apply.

Those who are not citizens of Japan and have stayed less than 3 years in Japan, regardless of his/her nationality, may apply to take an academic achievement test with hiragana rubi (furigana) to aid with reading if the high school conducts academic achievement tests made by Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education. Besides, he/she may be allowed to bring in a dictionary and have extended time when taking the academic achievement test with hiragana rubi (furigana). (However, for a Japanese academic achievement test, he/she is not allowed to bring in any dictionary and have extended time.) If he/she has stayed in Japan for 3 years or more but less than 6 years, then he/she can also take the test with hiragana rubi (See A13).

In addition, under set eligibility requirements, Takenodai, Tagara, Minami Katsushika, Fuchu Nishi, Asuka, Rokugo Koka, Suginami Sogo and Kokusai high schools hold entrance examinations for foreign students residing in Tokyo for April and September enrollment (no September enrollment for Rokugo Koka and Suginami Sogo high schools). However, in the case a candidate is accepted by any of the seven high schools besides Kokusai high school, he/she may not apply to Kokusai high school, which will hold the examination at a later date, even if the candidate does not complete the admission procedure of the accepted school.

Q20 島しょ以外の中学校から、島しょの都立高校(全日制)に応募できますか。

A20 入学日までに、保護者とともに島しょに転居するか、保護者に代わる島しょに在住の身元引受人のもとに転居することが確実な場合には、島しょの都立高校に応募することができます。

Q21 定時制又は通信制の都立高校に応募するには、どのような条件がありますか。

Q19. Can a student enrolled at a junior high school on one of Tokyo's islands apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school (full-time) on the mainland?

A19. A student may apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on the mainland if it is certain that he/she can relocate with his/her guardian(s) (if the guardians are his/her parents, both the mother and father or either of them), or he/she will live under the care of a "guarantor" (adult relative, etc.) who resides in Tokyo (on the mainland) and will act as his/her guardian prior to enrollment.

A student dormitory director (who is always stationed and acts as a guardian) may also serve as a guarantor.

Q20. Can a student enrolled at a junior high school on the mainland apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school (full-time) on one of Tokyo's islands?

A20. A student may apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on one of Tokyo's islands if it is certain that he/she can relocate with one of his/her guardians, or he/she will live under the care of a "guarantor" (adult relative) who resides in the Tokyo's island and will act as his/her guardian prior to enrollment.

In addition, a student who passed the selection process for accepting students from outside Tokyo's islands, which is implemented by towns and villages of Tokyo's islands on their own, may also apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on one of Tokyo's islands.

Furthermore, some towns or villages of Tokyo's islands will offer the opportunity for junior high school students to experience a short stay in Tokyo's islands so that they can participate in nature-experience activities and visit high schools before enrollment. The details of the application have been announced on the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education website.

Q21. What are the conditions for applying to a part-time or correspondence metropolitan high school?

A21. To apply to a part-time school, you must first be expected to graduate or have graduated from junior high school. On top of that, those who have an address or place of employment in Tokyo and are certain to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo after enrollment, or those who are certain to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo by the date of enrollment and are certain to continue to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo after enrollment are eligible to apply.

The eligibility for applying to a correspondence school are those who fall under the above and can respond to (attend) the interview guidance (schooling) conducted by such metropolitan high schools.
