## Q22 「中学校での欠席が多い場合、欠席の事情を都立高校に説明できると聞きましたが、どのような 方法がありますか。

A22 伝えたい欠席の事情を「自己的告書」の角紙に記えし、出願的に志願する高校へ提出することで、事情を説明することができます。「自己的告書」の角紙は、都立高校等の惣白で配布します。 や学校からの配布を希望する場合は、や学校の先生に相談してください。

自己的告書は、志願者及び保護者が記入し、厳封して、入学願書等の出願書類とともに志願する 都立高校に提出することになります。


## Q23 首 PRカードとはどのようなものですか。

> 自己PRカードを点数化することはありませんが、簡接を行う場合の簡接資料や入 試の合格判定資料の一部として活用したり、学校生活に対する意欲等を確認したりする資料になります。

面接を実施する高校を志願する場合は、 この自己PRカードを出願時に志願する 高校へ提出します。

面接を実施しない高校を志願する場合は、 できなく できた 後に入学する高校へ提出し、 できなく の個人面談等で使用します。





- Q22. I understand that if I have a poor attendance record at junior high school, I can have the opportunity to explain the circumstances surrounding my absences to a Tokyo metropolitan high school. How do I go about doing this?
- **A22.** You can explain it by filling in a "Personal Declaration Form" to convey the reason behind your absences and submitting it to the high school you wish to apply to at the time of application. Forms are available at Tokyo metropolitan high schools and related offices. If you wish to obtain a form at your junior high school, please consult with your teacher.


## Q23. What is a self-introduction card?


A23. A self-introduction card should be filled in with what you want to convey the most to the high school you will apply to such as what you have learned and gained through study and various activities in your junior-high-school life.

The self-introduction card will not be scored. However, it is used as reference for the interview test and a part of the resources to make a pass/fail judgement for the entrance examination and to see the applicant's motivation toward his/her school life.

If you apply to a high school which requires an interview test, you need to submit this self-introduction card to the high school you will apply to at the time of application.

If you apply to a high school that does not require interview tests, you need to submit it to the high school you are admitted to after completing the entrance procedure so that the school will use it for personal interviews, etc. following admission.





\* If you apply to one of the Challenge schools, you need to submit a prescribed form, "Declaration for Application" instead of this selfintroduction card.

Summarize your learning and other activities of your junior high school life.

- **A24** 入試における透明性の確保を自的として、「本人得点の開示」及び「学力検査における答案の開示」の制度があります。

開示請求の受付は、3月から(合格者は5月から)8月までの期間となります。開示請求書を受検した高校に提出し、本人確認ができるもの(受検票や身分証明書など)を提示することにより、学力検査等の得点が記載された表や学力検査における答案の写しを受け取ることができます(保護者が開示請求する場合は、受検票と保護者の本人確認ができるものの両方の提示が必要です。)。また、窓口での申請に加えて、電子での申請も行えます。

手続の方法などについては、11月上旬に発行予定の「令和6年度東京都立高等学校募集案内」で確認してください。

- Q24. If I want to know my score on the academic achievement tests, etc. or want to see my answer sheets after the exam results have been announced, what should I do?
- **A24.** There are systems of "Disclosure of a Candidate's Score" and "Disclosure of Answer Sheets of an Academic Achievement Test" with the objective of ensuring the transparency in academic achievement tests.

Requests are responded from March (while for successful candidates, from May) to the end of August.

You may receive a score sheet of your achievement test, etc. or a copy of your answer sheets for an academic achievement test after the results have been announced by submitting a disclosure request to the high school where the test was taken and by presenting some form of identification (such as your admission ticket or ID). (If your guardian requests the disclosure, both your admission ticket and your guardian's ID are required.) You can also request electronically in addition to requesting at the counter.
